

At the community consultation meeting (28 APRIL 21), the Principal from Emmaus College stated that Closing Remarks now that the access to Bakers Lane has now been closed and truck movements are no longer an ongoing concern he wished to thank Goodman and their sub consultants for the strong relationship between the School and the Project, responsiveness to issues and communications in general. 14. Photos and comments from inspections Date, Location & Comment **OWIE Infrastructure - 6 APRIL 21** Estate basin 1 is full and overflowing following a series of several significant rainfall events. Inflows to the basin are still occurring and it will be treated once the **OWIE Infrastructure - 6 APRIL 21** A single failure of drainage structures has occurred at the northern extent of the western landscape bund. This drainage had been completed per specification and signed off as meeting PC. **OWIE Infrastructure - 12 APRIL 21** A berm has been provided the perimeter of Precinct 5 pad to prevent water flowing towards the North. This area will then be progressively filled moving northwards. It was discussed that the sediment controls (sediment fence) at the Northern extent should be maintained to accommodate the extension of pad to Precinct 5.

It was discussed that the main sediment control Basin currently holds approximately 2000 m3 with additional capacity provided by adjacent and other larger excavations.

It was indicated that the basin is to be enlarged to approximately 4000 m3 to make management of surface water and dewatering more efficient



### **OWIE Infrastructure -28 APRIL 21**

The waste management area was inspected and discussed. Improvements in this area were raised as part of the recent audit

Material is being actively separated however greater attention may be paid to general housekeeping in this area.

This issue will be again reviewed in subsequent inspections
